Life jackets are available, also for children. Entrance fee for the Marine Park is 2.500 fc or 5 euros per adult to be paid to the Village Association of Nioumachoua; valid for the duration of your stay.</i>

Important Notice

All visits and hikes are made under the entire and the sole responsibility of the clients. The Hotel cannot be held responsible for any accidents. You are kindly requested to verify whether all passengers on board can swim or are wearing a life jacket. Do not wander too far in the Ocean and be aware of strong currents.

We strongly advise to wear protective clothing for the sun and proper shoes. Be very careful not to injure yourself on the coral reef and wear closed shoes for hiking (bites of centipedes can be very painful). Do not pick up or touch corals when snorkelling (the coral would need three years to rejuvenate). Never put your fingers or hand in holes in the reef or giant shells. Fish such as the Lion Fish and the Rock Fish are extremely poisonous and can cause death. Be wary of moray eels and stings from small octopus and sea urchins.

It is prohibited to collect and export corals. In general we ask you to respect the environment of the National Marine Park recognised by the United National Environmental Programme.

Do not litter or throw cigarettes. We separate bio-degradable waste and organic waste from the other waste. Tin cans as well as plastic bottles are collected separately.

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Prices include a commercial tax of 10%.
